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# Mains & Battery Powered

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## Mains Powered

- 1) Make sure the rocker switch on the back of the unit is switched off, as well as switching off the power sockets on the wall before plugging the power cable in to them.
- 2) Plug the power cable into the back of the unit, then into the wall socket and switch both switches on.

## Battery Powered

- 1) Make sure the rocker switch on the back of the unit is switched off, and the battery is powered off, before plugging any cables into them.
- 2) Plug the power cable into the back of the unit, then into the battery (the socket for the battery is located under the cover labeled 'AC')
- 3) Switch on both the unit and the battery via the rocker switches.
- 4) Press the battery power button once (this should switch on some blue lights next to the button, these indicate the battery's charge). Once these lights show, press and hold the power button, this will switch the battery on.

The screen will automatically turn on once the unit has been powered.

Please note: Batteries must have fuses in to work.



# Charging the Battery

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Please note: These instructions are only applicable if you purchased a battery.

- 1) Turn the battery off.
- 2) Plug the charging cable into the port labeled "IN 15V". This port will be found under the cover labeled "DC & USB" on the battery.
- 3) Plug the 3-pin plug into your power source.



Please note: Batteries must have fuses in to work.



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
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# Adjusting the Height/Angle

The height and tilt adjustment buttons are located on the side of the unit. There are four arrows - two of which point up, and two of which point down. To adjust the height, push one of the arrows on the right in the desired direction. To adjust the angle, push one of the arrows on the left in the desired direction.

Adjust the height



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
# Guidance

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## Projected Capacitive Touch Technology

When using the touchscreen, the gesture functions are very similar to using a smartphone or tablet on a larger scale.

The way Projected Capacitive Touch works is by fixing a sensor grid between a layer of cover glass and the LCD panel, so that when a finger touches the glass the grid detects the coordinates of the touch point. With this type of touch technology, no raised bezel is required.



## Screen Cleaning

Over time and use, the screen will become tarnished with finger prints; to clean, a mist spray glass cleaner / degreaser should be used when the screen is at a 45 degree angle. Should any liquid be dropped on the screen when in its horizontal position, this should be mopped up with a liquid absorbent cloth prior to cleaning.



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


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## Moving the Varitilt Standard Plus

When moving the Varitilt Standard Plus, ensure the screen is flat, and the wheels are unlocked. To unlock the wheels, lift the pedal up with your foot until the brake releases. Confirm that all brakes are unlocked before attempting to move the unit.



Once the unit is where you want it to be, ensure the wheels are locked to prevent any unwanted movement. To lock the wheels, press down on the brake pedal with your foot until you feel a click that indicates the brake is engaged.



# Guidance

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## Switching between Android and Windows OS

Please note: The following instructions are only applicable if you have purchased an OPS PC with the Varitilt Standard Plus.

To switch to the OPS PC input:

- 1) Swipe in from either the left or right hand side of the screen.
- 2) Press the Windows icon



To switch back to Android OS:

- 1) Click one of the arrows on the left or right hand side of the screen
- 2) Press the home button



## Installing Applications from the Google Play Store

- 1) From the home screen, click "More Apps".
- 2) Click on the Google Play Store icon.
- 3) Log in to/register your account.
- 4) Find applications you want to install in the Google Play Store.
- 5) Install the application by pressing the "Install" button.
- 6) This application will now install and be available in the "More Apps" menu from the Home Screen.





The Whiteboard has a default gray grid background. It allows for single-point, brush-free handwriting and is ready for immediate use

Click to select a colour.



Click for a regular pencil.



Click to adjust the pencil's thickness.



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
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# Whiteboard Software

Click this button to select your content to copy and paste or delete it.




Click this button to switch between a single touch point (for drawing/writing) and multiple touch points

Click this icon to share your work as a QR code. Turn on the switch to require a password to view. The password is to the left of the switch. (Only available with an internet connection).




Click this icon to send an email. (Only available with an internet connection).

Click this icon to open additional tools - pictured below. switch the tools on and click confirm to see them in the tool bar along the bottom:



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
# Screen Casting



Click the "Wireless Projection" icon from the home page. The image below is what will be displayed when the application opens.



On an Android phone, you can scan the QR Code on the left using your Camera app to download the screen-casting software. If you have an iPhone or want to connect a PC/Mac, press the "instructions" button at the bottom of the screen.



Follow the on-screen instructions for your device.



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
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


# Home Screen


To access the screen casting settings, press the settings button - circled below:



The settings below will appear:



Moderator: When this option is activated, a hover menu will appear to assist hosts in managing screen casting, as illustrated below:



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
# Screen Casting

Show notification message when device connected: When activated, a welcome message will pop-up when screen casting begins, and a goodbye message will pop-up when disconnected.


Lock aspect ratio: When activated, the aspect ratio of the original source will be locked.

Device password: By default, this password is 12345678, which can be changed.

Dynamic device password: Allows for a dynamic password that changes automatically when a specified amount of time has passed.




Display mode: Change the amount of images displayed.



Single Image > Screen rotation: Change the orientation of the screen.

Single Image > Exclusive mode: Once exclusive mode is activated, when a device is casting, other devices cannot interrupt or override the screen cast.

# Screen Casting



Multiple Images > Layout: By default, the display screens are equally proportioned. If the display ratio of one screen casting signal is larger than that of the others, you can switch the main screen.

Multiple Images > Double click the window: Full screen display by default.

Multiple Images > Stretch to full height under two images mode: In dual-phone screen casting, the sides may not be displayed due to the display proportion. When this option is turned on, the display proportion will be adjusted to fill the screen.



Mirror Back > Resolution: Change the resolution.

Mirror Back > Frame Rate: Change the frame rate

Mirror Back > Max. Devices: Change the maximum numbers of devices allowed to screen-cast at once.



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# Screen Casting

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Mirror Back > Mirror back mode: The anti-mirror function is enabled by default.

Mirror Back > Touch control: Open the QuickShare application on your mobile phone, search for USBDisplay\_xxxx in the lower right corner, and click Desktop Sync. Once the anti-mirror is successful, the Android phone screen will display on a larger screen, and the phone can control the large screen by touch.

Mirror Back > Annotation Authorisation Type: This setting allows you to configure annotation permissions in anti-mirror mode.

Mirror Back > Maximum Number of Simultaneous Annotators: This setting allows you to specify the number of users who can annotate at the same time. However, only one person can write at a time.



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

Click this icon to open the file browser (pictured above)



Click to change the displayed time / date.



Click to activate the Child Lock. The default password for the child lock is 2580.



Click to activate the energy saving feature.



Click to take a screenshot. This will save to the local memory.



Click to open the screen recording feature. recordings will be saved in the MP4 format and in the BSDScreen folder.



Click to open magnifier, which allows you to enlarge fonts and images in Android.

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# Troubleshooting

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## Device not switching on

- Make sure that the rocker switch on the back of the unit is switched on, as well as the switches for the power source.
- Make sure the power cables are securely plugged into both the device and power source.
- If the unit is battery powered, make sure the battery is charged.
- If the unit is battery powered, make sure the battery is switched on. Once the rocker switch is on, press the power button once, followed by a press and hold.

## Battery not switching on

- Make sure the battery is charged. You can check this by pressing the power button on the battery once. The lights next to the power button will light up depending on the battery's power level. If no/one light shows, the battery needs to be charged.

## Height/angle not adjusting

- Make sure the power cables are securely fitted into both the unit and the power source and make sure both are switched on.
- The unit may have reached it's limits. Try and move the height/angle in the opposite direction.

## Why can't I install applications?

- Make sure you are connected to the internet. You can check this via the settings menu.
- You may have run out of storage and need to uninstall some existing applications to create room for more. You can check how much storage space you have left in the settings menu.

## Why is the battery not charging?

- Make sure the charger is switched on at the power source.
- The charger consists of two cables. The lead that connects to the battery unit needs to be connected into the charging brick. Make sure the lead is fully inserted into the brick.
